Let's start to new experiences through the volunteer leadership of an international Work Camp

The Ecumenical Youth Services (EYS) are planning international work camps in summer 2020 and offer you the opportunity to get involved as a volunteer leader.

EYS work camps are camps of young people (17-26 years) from all over Europe and the world. By participating in the work camp, young people can get involved in meaningful, socially relevant projects for a period of 2 weeks and also get various opportunities for international exchange. The 1st Ecumenical International Building-up Camp took place in France in 1947!

You

- are 18 - 29 years old and
- would like to lead a 2-week camp with 15 participants within a team
- can communicate in German/English
- approach other people, cultures and ways of life with a lot of pleasure and joy.
- enjoy working in a team
- come off with little sleep for 2 weeks

It's coming to you:

- participation in a preparatory seminar
- if required, a visit to the camp site before the start of the Work Camp
- Arrival 2 days before camp start
- a 2-week Work Camp with an international group of 15 participants
- the follow-up of the camp

Concrete tasks of you and your team are:

- Be the contact person for the camp participants and the camp partner on site.
- Preparation and implementation of leisure activities (excursions, games, ...)
- Develop rules with the group
- Accompany group processes
- Organisation and structure of the daily routine
- Planning grocery shopping
- Active participation in the Work Camp work
- Administration and accounting of finances during and after the Work Camp

That's what we offer you:

- an ecumenical, international group with nice committed young people
- the opportunity to take part in meaningful projects through voluntary commitment and to gain experience in the voluntary management of a camp yourself
- participation in the free preparatory seminar from April, 29th - May, 3rd 2020
- the subsidisation of the seminar travel costs with a maximum of 95.00€ (for people from Germany) or 120€ (for people from outside Germany)
- the assumption of the travel costs for the camp
- Insurance in the camp
- a lump-sum expense allowance of 130,00€ for the camp
- Recognition by certificate
